## Summer Term 2 Curriculum

What's happening in Year 6 this term?

**Getting ready for the next step.**

During this term, the children in Y6, will be preparing to celebrate their time at Leighswood, as well as looking forward to their exciting journey ahead.

### **ENGLISH**

Throughout the year, the children have worked extremely hard to expand the range of skills they use when they are writing to make exceptional progress.

This term we will be looking for every opportunity in English lessons, and in other areas of the curriculum, to use their English skills confidently in preparation for Secondary School.

We will also be developing Speaking and Listening and production skills as we prepare for our end of year performance.

### **MATHS**

During lessons they will be further developing their arithmetic skills to work towards securing formal calculation methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as expanding their ability to calculate using their 'Brain only' moment to prepare them for Y7.

We will also be using and applying maths skills within wider contexts by completing two topics called 'Mission to Mars' and 'Build a Skyscraper'.



## TOPIC

The title of our Imaginative Learning Project this term is **Healthy Heart**.

During this term the children will be using their scientific skills to gather data about how the body works and how we can keep healthy.

We will be launching our topic with a 'Bootcamp' on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> and Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June.

As part of this topic, we would like to extend our opportunities to be physical and ask that children can keep their P.E. kits in school at all times.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

PE sessions will continue to take place on Friday afternoons. On Fridays, the children will work with our specialist sports coach, who will develop the children's ball skills through team games and skills activities. Weather permitting, this session will mainly take place outside, so in addition to their normal PE kits of yellow T-shirt and royal blue shorts, children may wear trainers. **Ear-rings must be removed and long hair tied up for both sessions.**
