Coronavirus - updated guidance from the DfE

Your child should stay at home if they are unwell with a new, continuous cough or a high temperature (37.8C and above) to avoid spreading infection to others.

If your child should become unwell while they are at school with a new, continuous cough or high temperature, then we will call you and they will need to go home.

Please continue to reinforce good hygiene with your child around washing their hands, covering their mouth when coughing and always sneezing into a tissue and then throwing it in the bin.
