

## Action Plan for COVID September 2020

Do you have the symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19)? They are a high temperature (above 37.8), a new, continuous cough for more than four hours, or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste?

### Parent - Yes

1. Parent isolate for 10 days
2. Child isolates for 14 days
3. All other contacts no isolation needed
4. Get a test

### Child - Yes

1. Child isolates for 10 days
2. Class does not isolate
3. Get a test

### Negative

Child returns to school as soon as they have test result.

### What is a contact ?

If you have been within 2m of someone for more than 15 mins 2 days before they had a positive test

### If we have a localised lock down... SCHOOL ACTIONS

1. Place order for more laptops for PP,LAC and SW children – numbers to Dfe
2. Dongles – vouchers and tokens through Dfe
- 3. Remote Home Learning – Class Dojo Live lessons daily (may also include face to face for vulnerable and key workers, school will remain open but with reduced numbers unless we have a COVID case) Be Prepared !!!

4. Safe and well checks weekly for EHCP, SEN, Vulnerable children
5. FSM children – kitchen to provide food package/school provide vouchers food packages
