Cameras have now been installed in two locations along Broadmeadow, Aldridge. They will be in operation from midnight tonight.

These CCTV cameras will be able to monitor all traffic and parking infringements

Fixed penalty fines will be issued by the Police as follows:

Up to £100 fine and 3 points on your licence

Walsall Council will ensure that clear signage is posted in the surrounding areas.

Please make sure that any person bringing your child to school or collecting them is aware of the penalties for not parking appropriately.
